



Murray's Hellgrammite

Hook: TMC 5256 Size 8-16

Thread: 8/0 Black

Tail: Black Ostrich Herl

Hackle: Black Saddle Hackle

Body: Medium Black Chenille

Pinchers: Black Rubber

1. Tie in thread beginning at the hook eye down the hook shank to the bend. Then use medium lead wire, wrapping it up the hook shank, to add weight. Make several wraps over lead to secure.
2. The tail is about 20 strands of ostrich herl, and is about one and one-half times the length of the hook.
3. Tie a piece of chenille and the tip of black saddle hackle at the base of the tail.
4. Wrap the chenille up the shank tie off and clip excess.
5. Palmer the hackle over the body.
6. Tie a pair of black rubber material onto the hook, just behind the eye, cut pinchers to size and cement.
7. Go fishing. This fly has caught carp, catfish, bluegill and smallmouth bass.

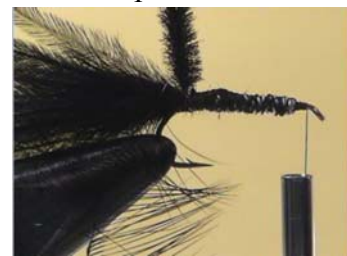
