

MVFF Casting Competition

Outdoor Competitions are as follows:

- **MAY - DRY FLY** (4 WT rod)
 - A maximum of 3 false casts per target will be allowed.
 - We will have you start with the fly in target 1 or in your hand. (Judge's decision on meeting night.)

- **JUNE – NYMPH** (4 WT rod)
 - Here are the rules for casting the nymph. You will start with the fly in target #2.
 - You will pick up the fly and have unlimited false casts to target #1.
 - You will then only be allowed 1 false cast to each remaining target.

- **JULY - ROLL CAST (MAX. OF 15 CASTS ALLOWED TO ATTEMPT ALL TARGETS)** (7 WT rod)
 - Here are the rules for the Roll Cast. Limit of 15 casts total.
 - Start with fly in target #1. Cast to target #1 until scored (inside one of the rings).
 - Then on to the remaining 4 targets or until a maximum of 15 casts are made.
 - Any target not scored is a demerit of "-2" points. Highest score with fewest casts wins.

- **AUGUST - BASS BUG** (7 WT rod)
 - Start with bug in hand and allowed unlimited casts to target 1.
 - Then only two (2) false casts to all remaining targets.

- **SEPTEMBER - DISTANCE COMPETITION (USING AN AVERAGE OF SEVERAL CASTS)** (7 WT rod)
 - Make 5 casts MAX (in 5 minutes). (minimum of 3 casts)
 - While we may not enforce the 5 minute rule, we do want to give everyone a chance to cast and still have time to eat dinner. No fly, just a piece of yarn.
 - Tip: While there are no rules about how many false casts you can make, the fewer you make, the better your results will be. And don't rush the cast – give the rod time to load.
